# Shackleton - Day One

## Welcome to Shackleton Shire of Bruce Rock

**SHACKLETON**  
*The Town that Nearly Wasn't*

The Koolbyn Agricultural Area was surveyed in 1886. Koolbyn was gazetted as the town for the area. Settlers in surrounding areas included those at Cokine springs, 4 miles to the east. One of those settlers, Dr. Walter Jeremy, owned lot 224 of the Koolbyn area and privately surveyed the lots of a town on his land.

In 1913, the railway was through to Bruce Rock with sidings at Koolbyn and Cokine. However, they changed the name to Shackleton as there was confusion in the railway offices with Kookerbin near Lake Grace. The Shackleton community's survival was largely due to the fact that the Goulfield's Water Scheme came to Shackleton before Koolbyn.

The town wasn't officially gazetted by the government until 1951. By 1950 Shackleton was a prosperous town with a Post Office, Co-Op, McKay Agricultural Agency, newsagency, baker, 2 butchers, drapery greenhouses, pit & garage.

Shackleton has a proud sporting history with teams for football, cricket, tennis, hockey, soccer, basketball, table tennis and a golf club during these years.

Shackleton is a sheep, wheat and other cereal grain growing area.
