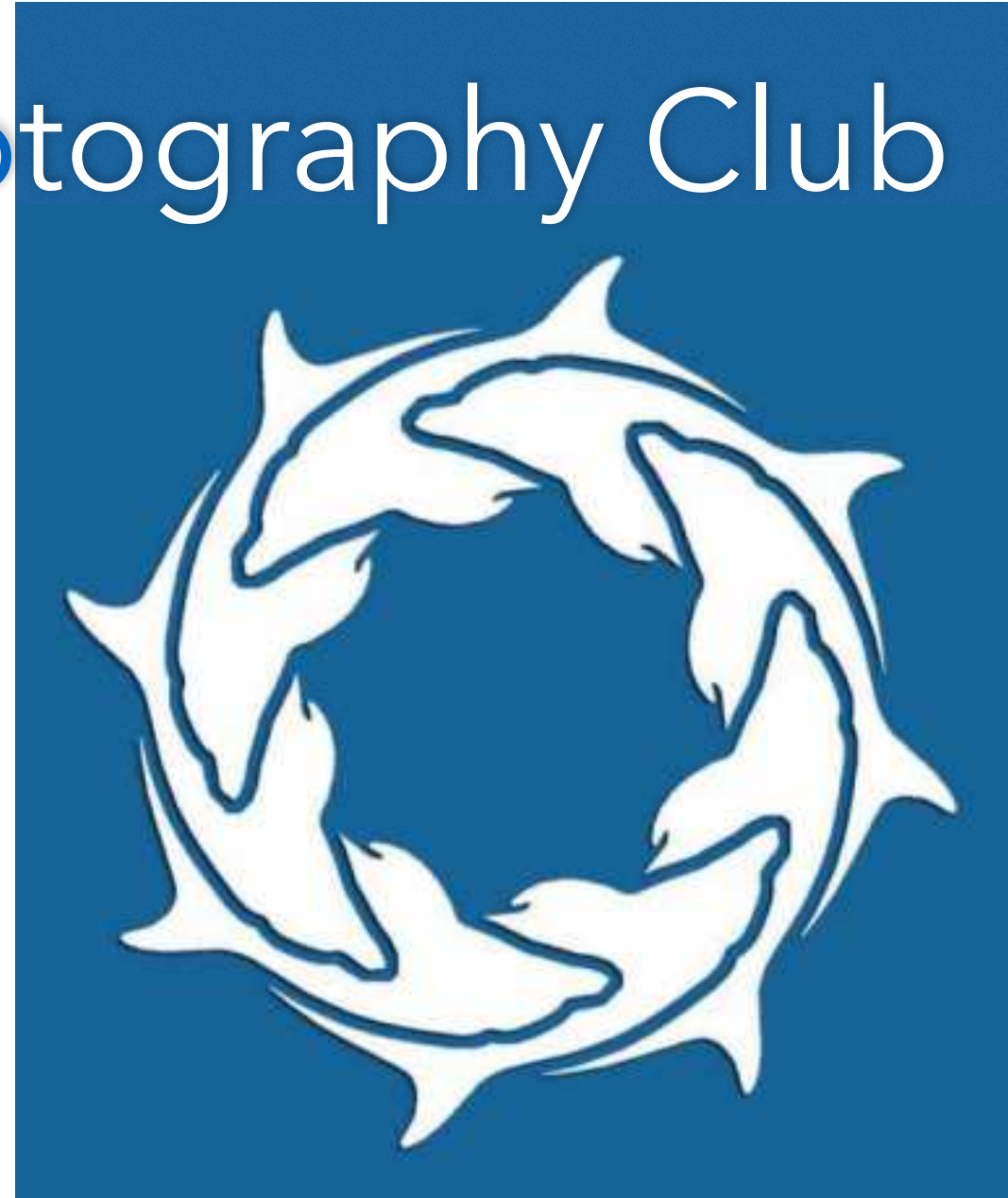

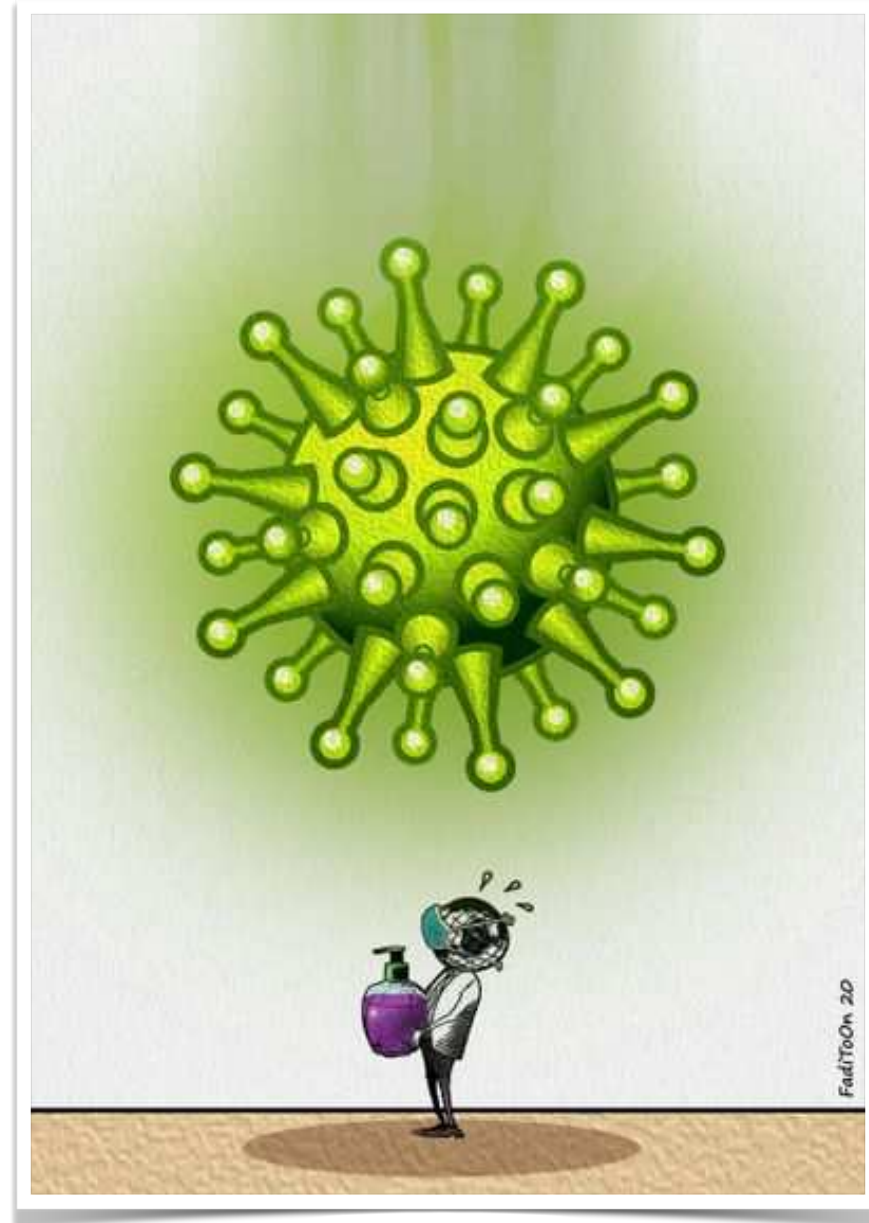
## COVID-19 - Stage 4

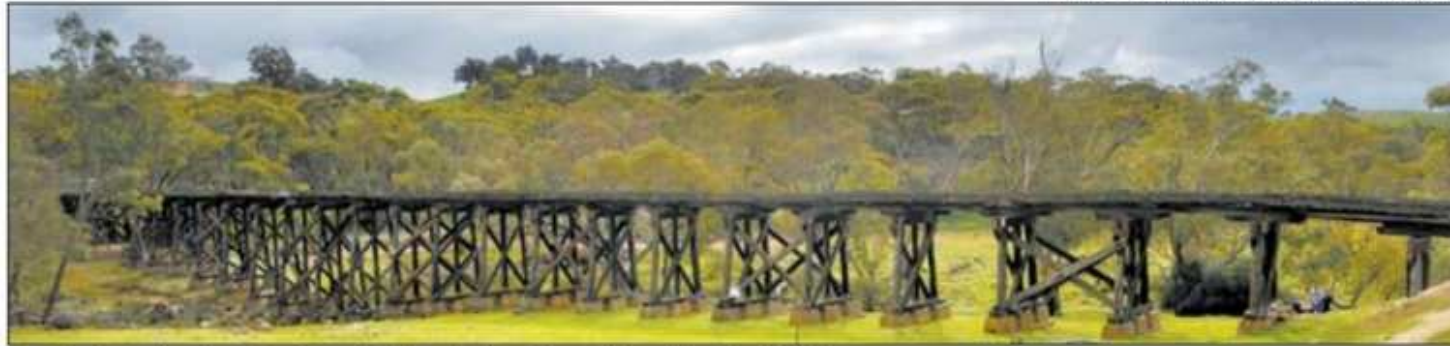
