


COVID-19 - Stage 4

January	12-Jan-21	19-Jan-21	Our Feathered Friends	An image taken of our feathered friends, this can be a bird at home, a bird in the landscape, and bird flying, a bird feeding, or a birds fighting (Can be a single image or a multiple bird image)	
February	2-Feb-21	9-Feb-21	We are Australian	An image that can depict our heritage, cultural diversity, rugged landscape, an Australian celebrations, or what makes us proud to be an Australian.	
March	2-Mar-21	9-Mar-21	A Sunset / Sunrise or Full Moon	An image of a sunset, sunrise or full moon rising or setting.	
April	6-Apr-21	13-Apr-21	Opposites	An image that shows an opposite e.g man and women, black and white, fruit and choclate etc.
