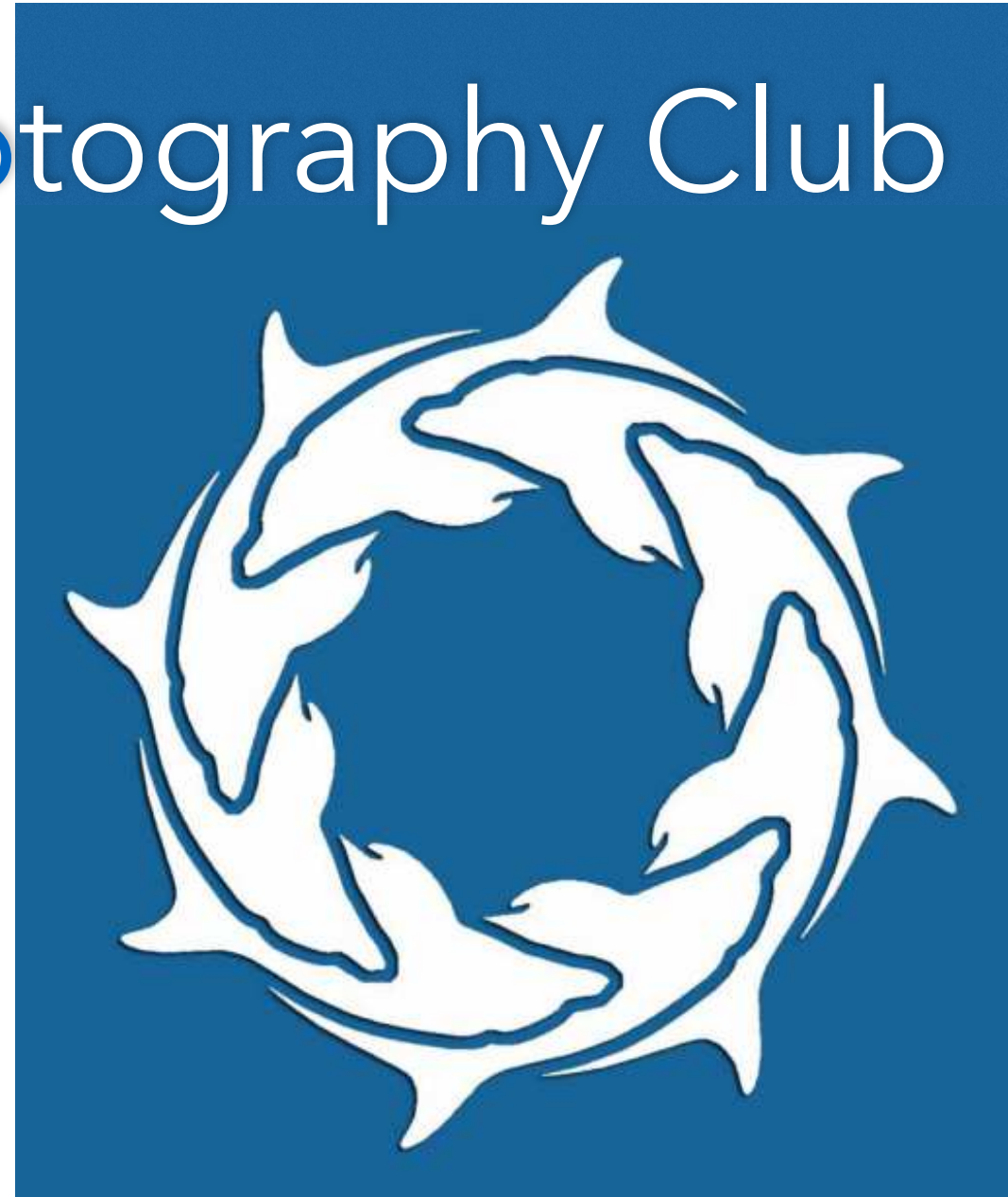

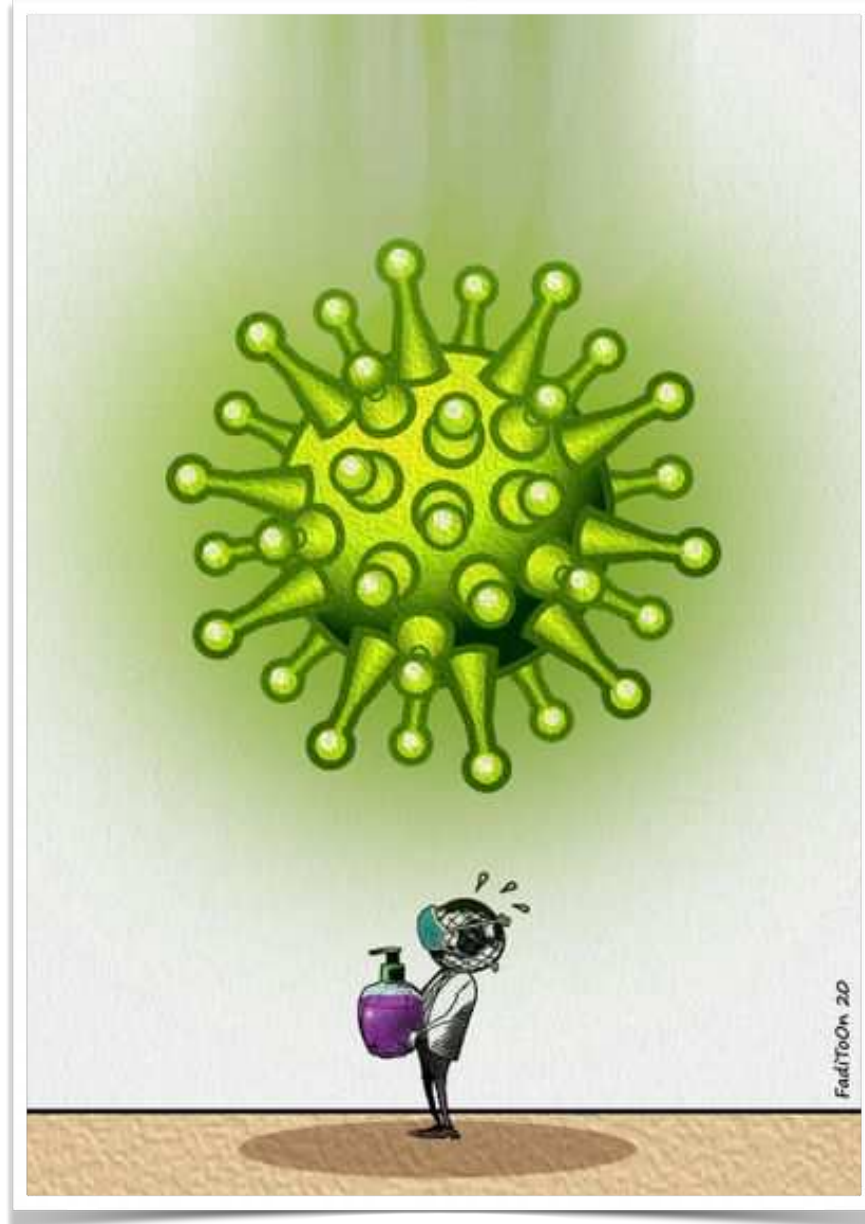
COVID-19 - Stage 4

Month	Image Submission Date	RPC Meeting Date	Theme	Definition	Judge
January	12-Jan-21	19-Jan-21	Our Feathered Friends	<i>An image taken of our feathered friends, this can be a bird at home, a bird in the landscape, and bird flying, a bird feeding, or a birds fighting (Can be a single image or a multiple bird image)</i>	
February	2-Feb-21	9-Feb-21	We are Australian	<i>An image that can depict our heritage, cultural diversity, rugged landscape, an Australian celebrations, or what makes us proud to be an Australian.</i>	
March	2-Mar-21	9-Mar-21	A Sunset / Sunrise or Full Moon	<i>An image of a sunset, sunrise or full moon rising or setting.</i>	
April	6-Apr-21	13-Apr-21	Opposites	<i>An image that shows an opposite e.g man and women, black and white, fruit and chocolate etc.</i>	
May	4-May-21	11-May-21	Black and White (Plus a printed image)	<i>A monochrome image, can be a landscape, portrait, still life, but must be a true monochrome image containing two tones.</i>	
June	1-Jun-21	8-Jun-21	Message and Meaning	<i>As a photographer we often talk about a storyline within your image, we want you to tell a visual story within your image. The image can be taken in any setting, but must have a visual storyline e.g. A person standing on a sand dune looking at a sunset, a child holding dad's hand etc.</i>

July	6-Jul-21	13-Jul-21	Xmas in July	<i>Replicate a Xmas theme image, it can be an image of Santa, or a mass setting, a child opening a present, or kissing under the mistle toe - but must be a Xmas theme.</i>	
August	3-Aug-21	10-Aug-21	Circles, Triangles, Squares or Rectangles (Plus a printed image)	<i>An image that portrays circles, these can be in the landscape, cityscape, impressionistic, abstract, or still life.</i>	
September	7-Sep-21	14-Sep-21	Isolation	<i>This can be related to a COVID 19 isolation, a person walking alone on the beach, a single person image displaying the devastation of being alone (elderly person), it can even be a street image.</i>	
October	5-Oct-21	12-Oct-21	The Colour Red	<i>An image that display's the colour 'Red', can be a red flower, the colour red, red tail lights, a red pattern, red clothing etc, but red must be dominant within the image.</i>	
November	2-Nov-21	9-Nov-21	Letters and Numbers (CALENDARS / PHOTOBOOKS DUE)	<i>An image that portrays letters or numbers, this can be numbers on a letterbox, letters or numbers on a building, letters and numbers within a book.</i>	
December	Nil	7-Dec-21	X-Mas Function,	<i>Photo-Books and Calendars and Awards</i>
