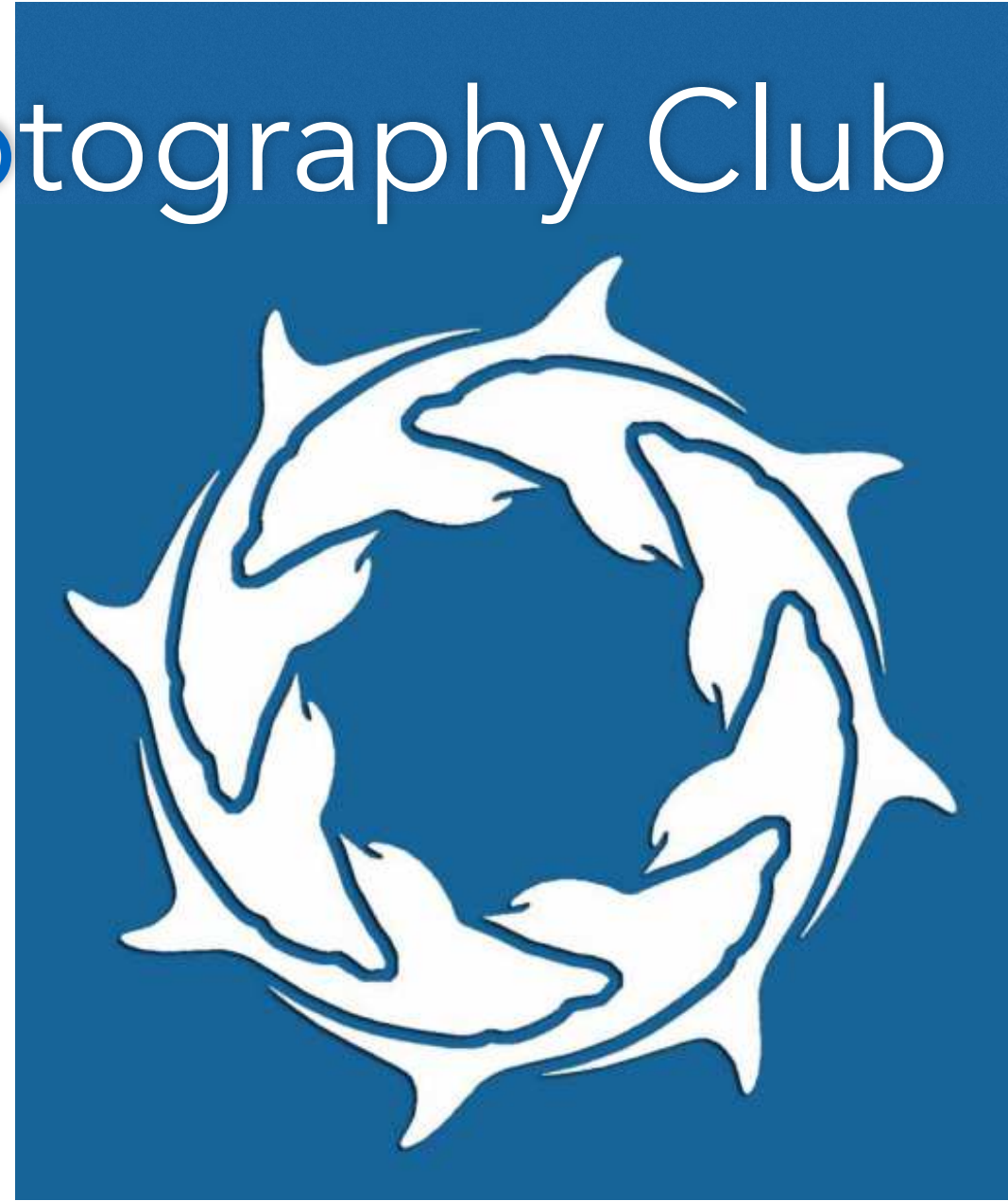

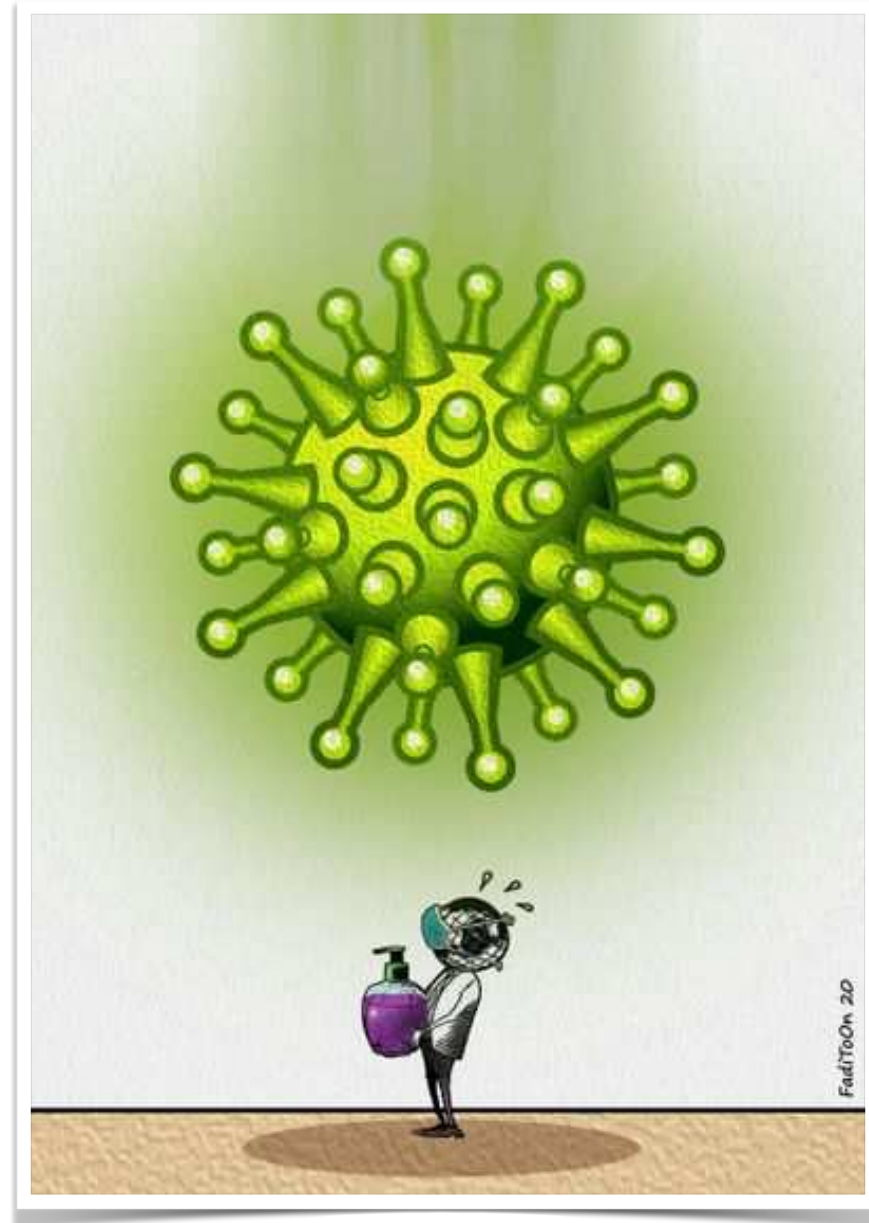


COVID-19 May 21 Update

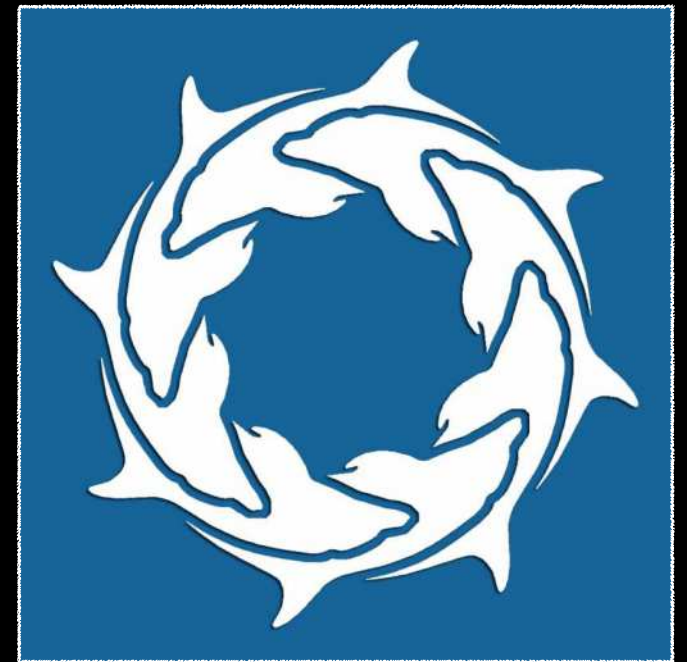

Tips on how to tell a Story with your images

- Tell a story in a single frame.
- Have an image set up (composition) in your mind and stick to that theme.
- Watch and Wait and try and try and plan your day.
- Trim and exclude any busy parts of the image.
- Emotions are an important part of storytelling.
- Composition and lighting.
- Mono works best for street images.


Your image needs to show the effect of a change to **our state, Western Australia**, and indicate in its **one word title** the sort of change that is happening.

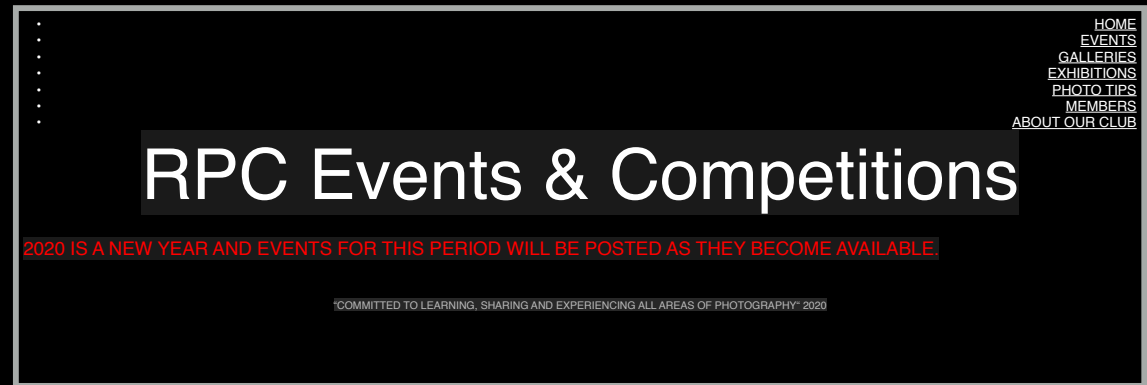
