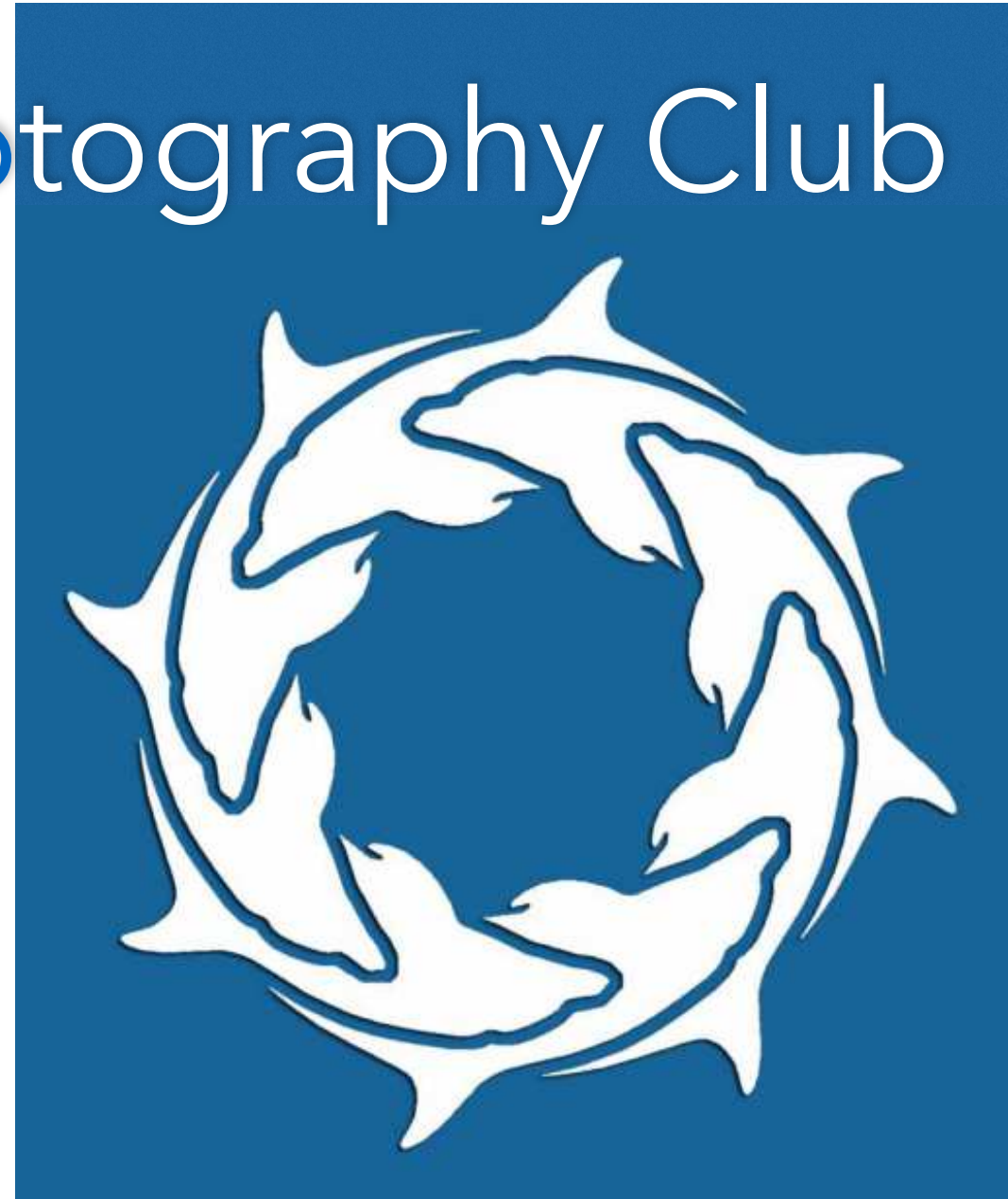

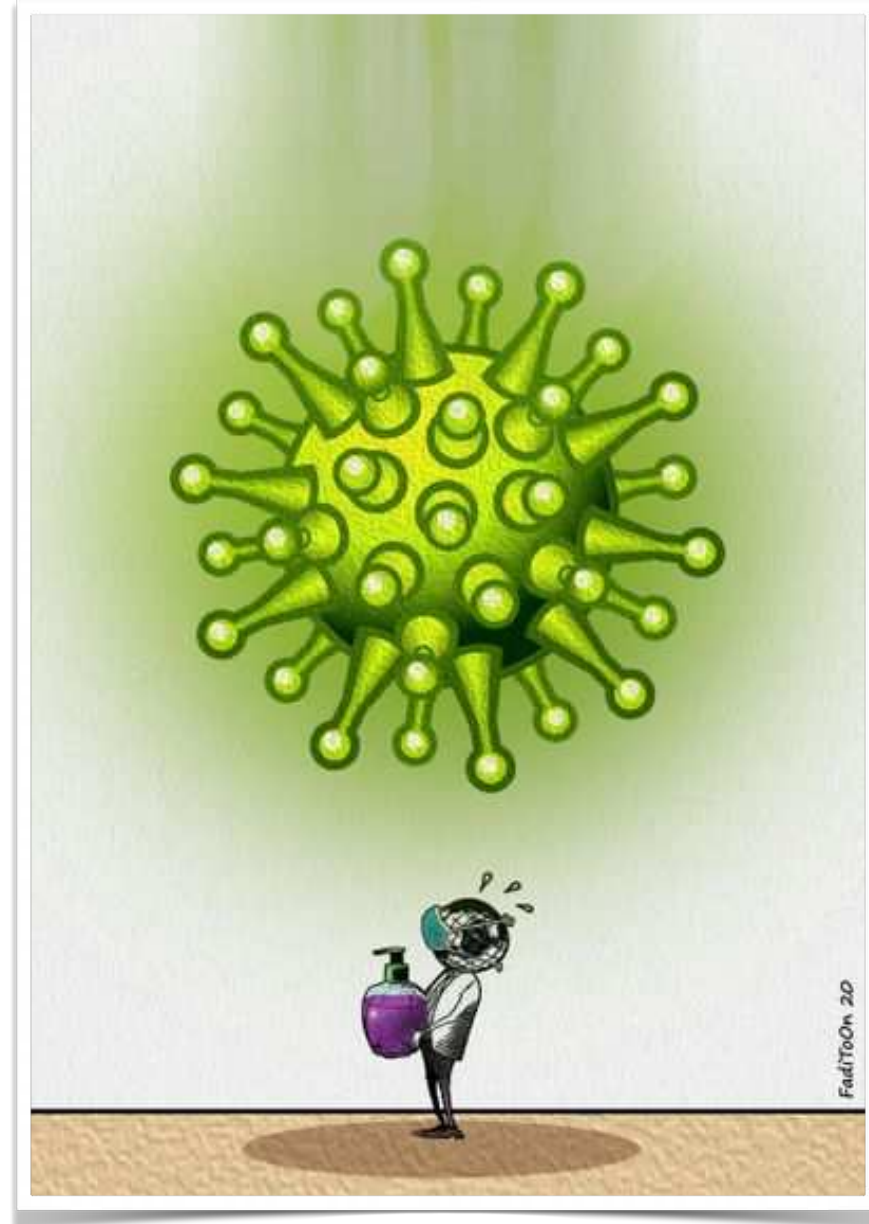


COVID-19 May 21 Update

Imaging and exhibited at the WA Maritime Museum. The winning entry will be chosen by the judging panel and announced at the prize presentation ceremony. Visitors to the museum will be invited to submit votes for a People's Choice prize.

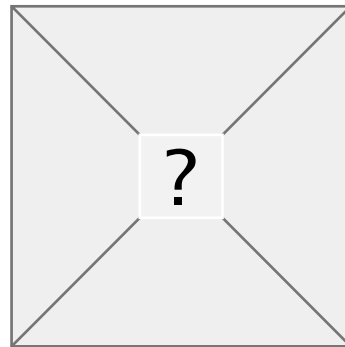

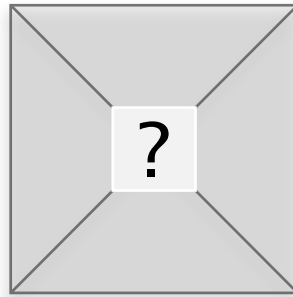
