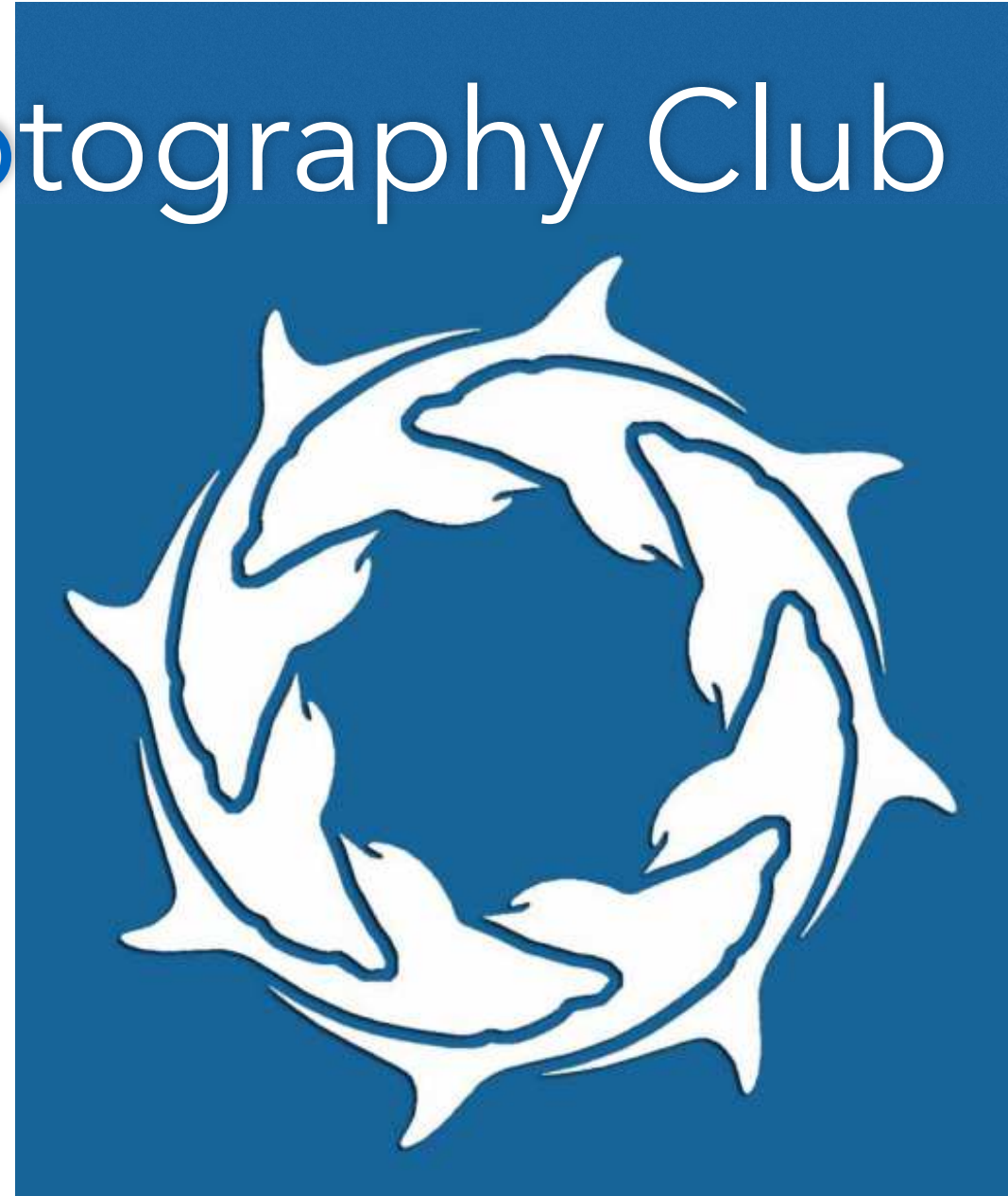

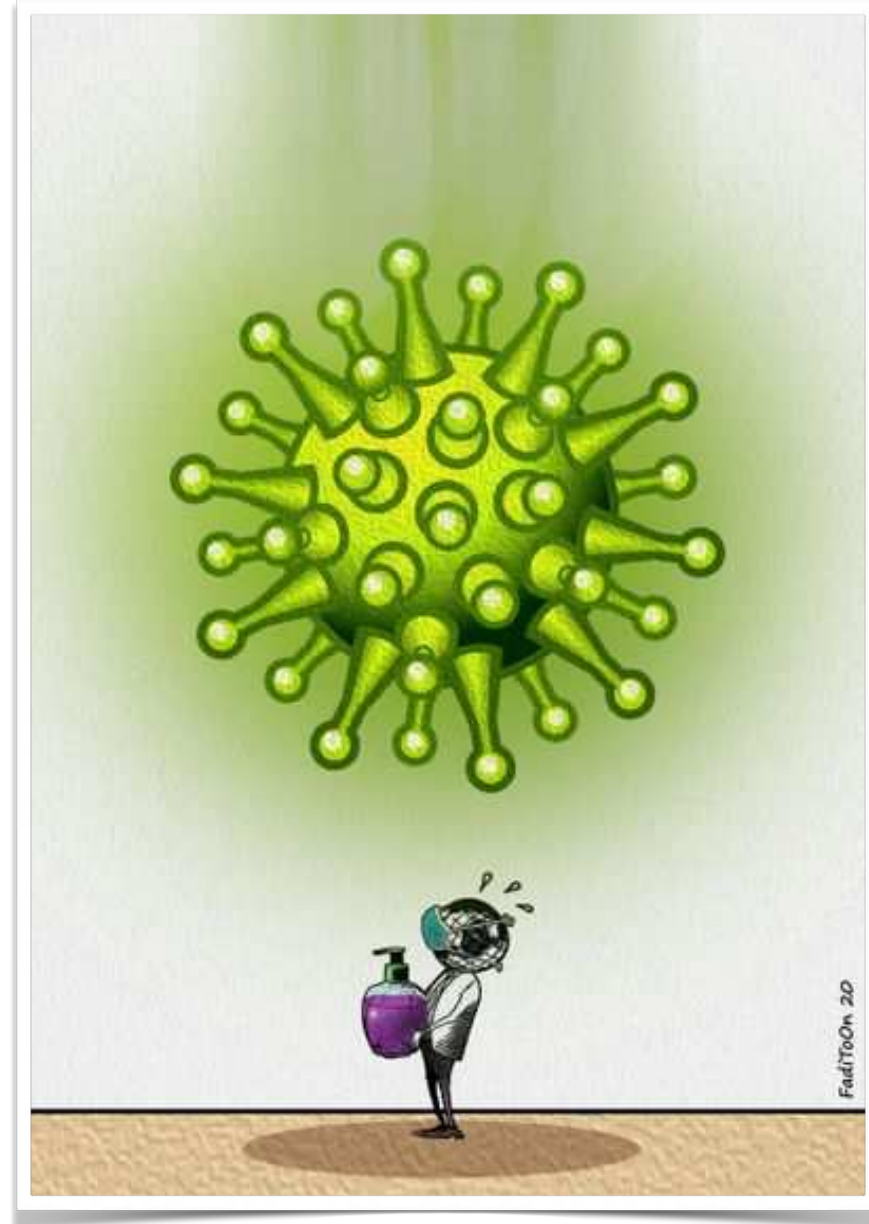


COVID-19 May 21 Update

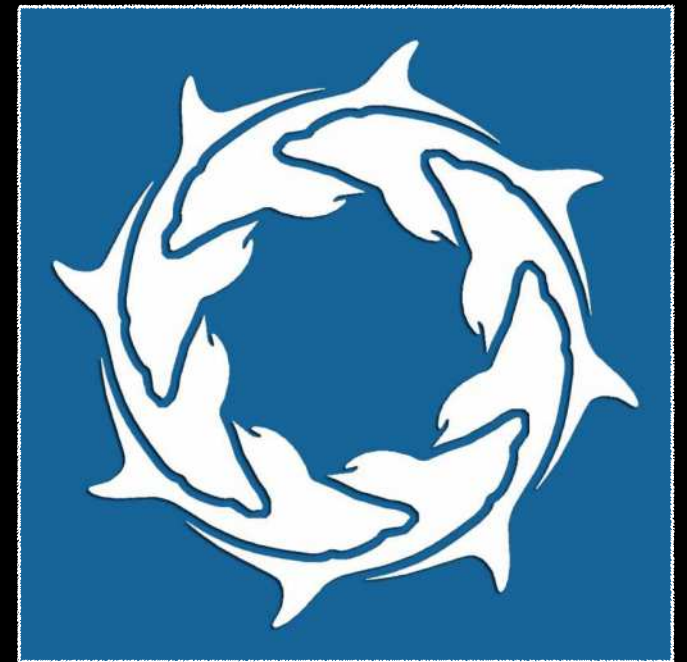

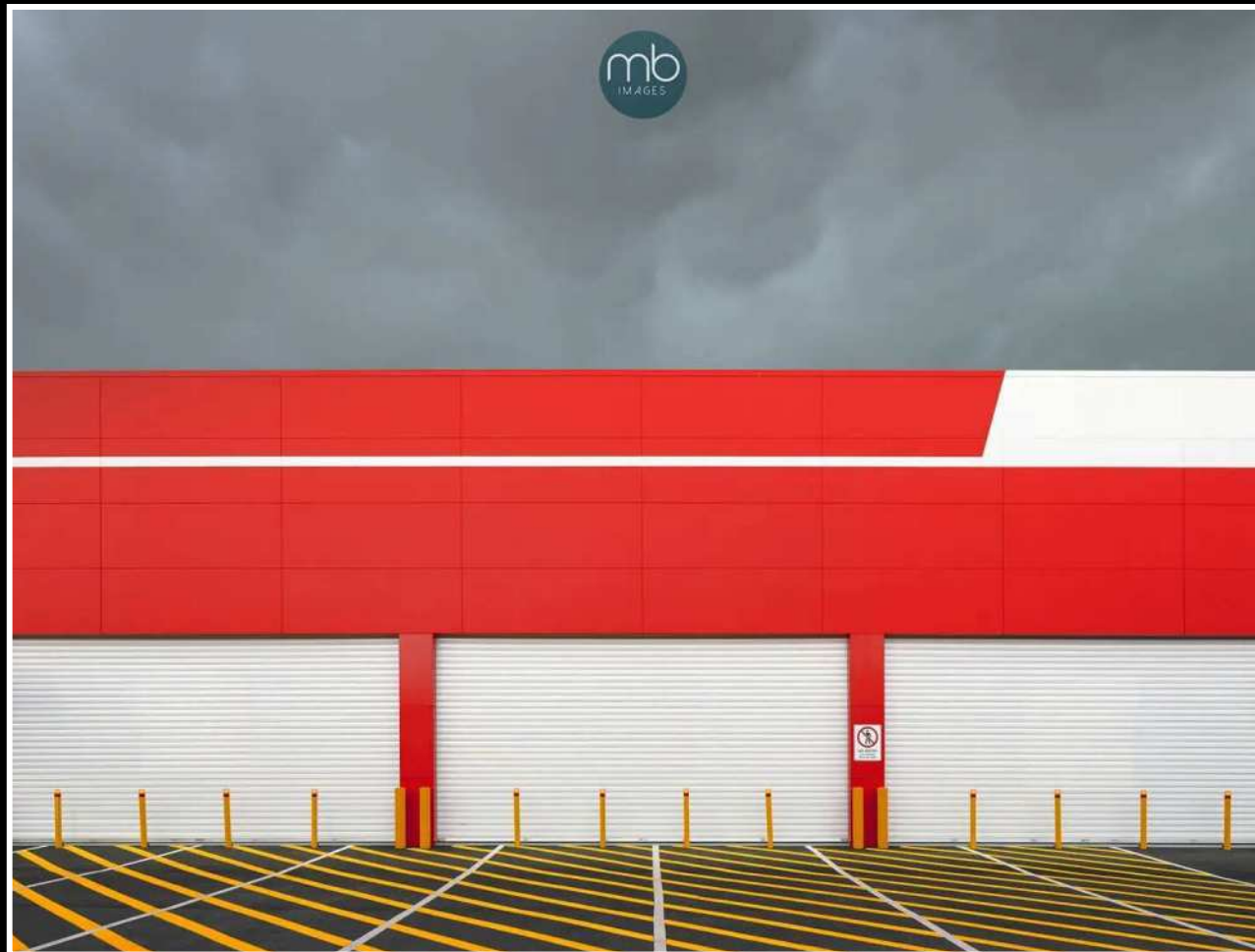


The Colour Red
