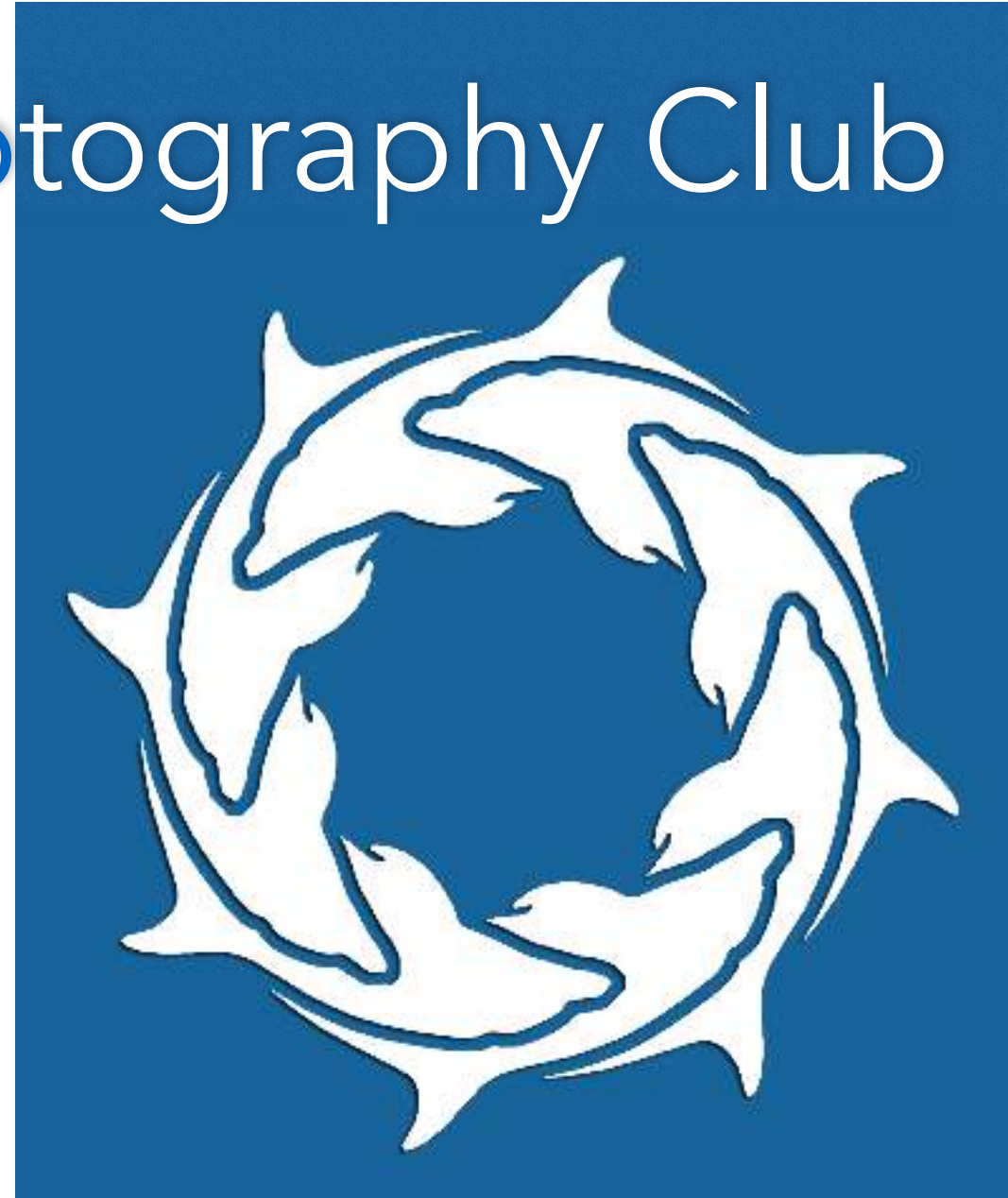

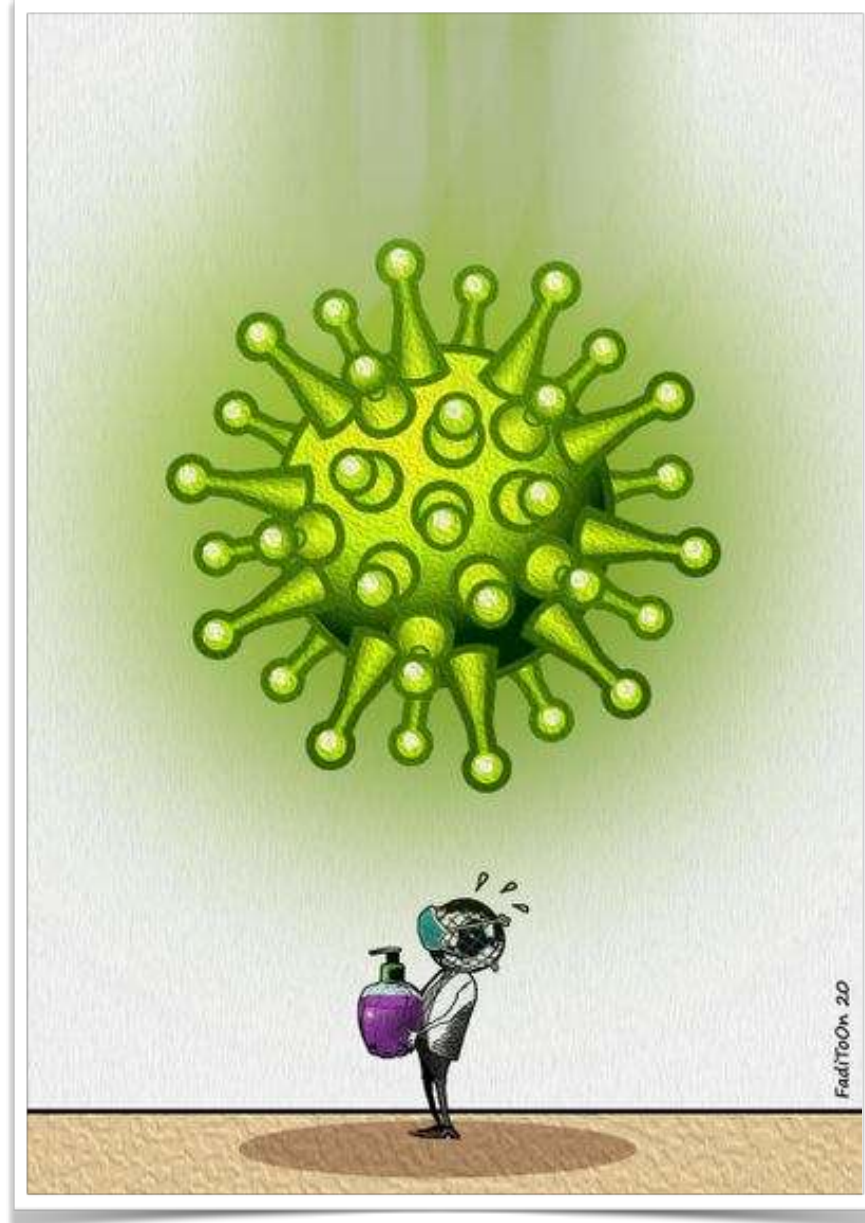


## COVID-19 May 21 Update

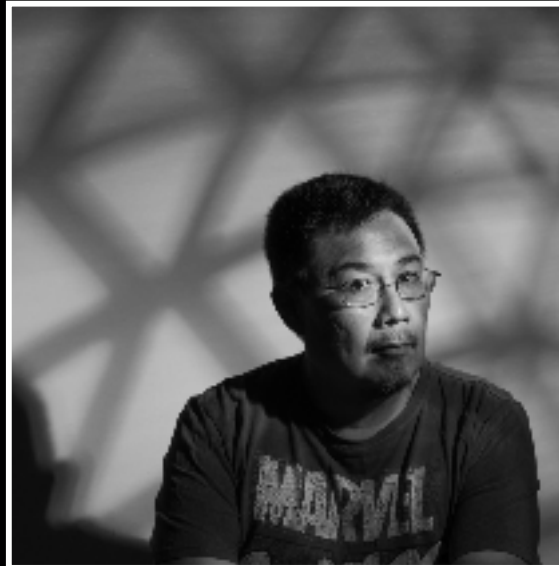

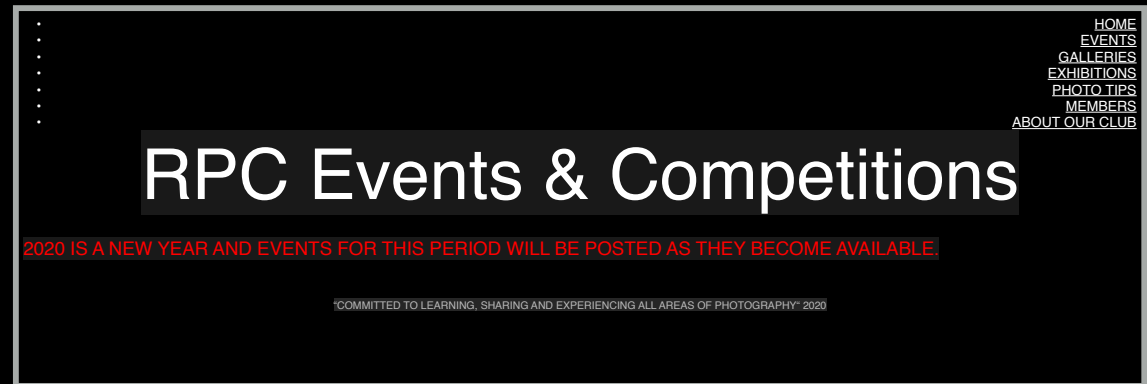
